

La genetica e il rinnovamento delle basi biologiche della diseguaglianza. Variabilità interindividuale o differenza tra gruppi?

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Abstract: The interaction of genetics with the biomedical sciences has added an explanation of the genetic factors of individual variation in the cultural and behavioural factors, understood as elements able to influence and accelerate the individual susceptibility to develop the disease. These developments bring to reflection legal arguments for reasoning about an unpublished version of the genetic bases of inequality. The issue of inequality has gained additional space in studies of population genetics, with hypotheses that support the utility of human categorization in biomedical research. This debate is interesting because it shows, putting out an impractical and naïve determinism, agrees to include the data as a factor in racial and culturally connoted, usefully be spent both in terms of understanding the causes of disease, which in the planning of preventive measures in terms of public policies.
