The Conception of Criminal Law in Benedetto Croce's Philosophy: the Purposes of Punishment Abstract: This essay deals with the subject of the purpose and function of criminal punishment in the philosopher Benedetto Croce's Frammenti, which were newly collected and edited in the 1931 volume Etica e Politica. Croce introduces a theory of the punishment ("emenda"), based on expiation and on contrition, far from any kind of "retribution" or "dissuasion".
