Reichlin and the Evolution of Utilitarian Moral Theory

Abstract: In his *L'utilitarismo*, M. Reichlin makes two methodological moves. First, he focuses on Utilitarianism exclusively regarded as a moral theory (let's call this Isolation). Second, he accounts for historical Utilitarianism as a succession of attempts to answer objections and the ensuing abandonment of distinctively utilitarian claims (let's call this Failed evolution). In this paper, I raise some objections to both assumptions.
