Greene's Moral Tribes: Thinking Too Fast and Too Slow

Abstract: Joshua Greene's attempt to propose a new metamorality, able to solve the Us-Them conflict and overcome the Tragedy of Commonsense Morality, heavily relies on the assumption that our moral machinery has a dual-mode of reasoning, one of which is biased by our natural evolution in small groups. But Greene's utilitarian solution is based on relevant experiments which seem to be still controversial in their interpretation.
