Free Will between Science and Neuroethics

Abstract: The problem of free will has recently been addressed scientifically. The example of the so-called readiness potential at the basis of Libet's experiments suggests not entrusting a debate that has a strong ethical implication and very relevant social consequences to experimental verification alone. In this sense, neuroethics as an interdisciplinary research field can help. A comparison with Magni's claims on these issues is made.
