Ethics and future generations. A Reply to Magni and Pellegrino

Abstract: Against Magni's attempts to show that narrow person-affecting consequentialism can cope with the asymmetry and the intransitivity of the relation 'better than', I maintain my previous criticism, that accepting the asymmetry and rejecting the principle of transitivity raises a host of problems that are much more troubling than those raised by accepting the repugnant conclusion. In reply to Pellegrino's criticism of an argument I have given in support of the acceptability of the repugnant conclusion, I recast the argument in a more precise way, and maintain that, so construed, the argument is immune to Pellegrino's criticism.
