R. Edward Freeman is University Professor, Elis and Signe Olsson Professor, Academic Director of the Business Roundtable Institute for Corporate Ethics, the Institute for Business in Society, and Senior Fellow of the Olsson Center for Applied Ethics at the University of Virginia Darden School of Business. His latest book is [*Stakeholder Theory: The State of the Art*](#), published by Cambridge University Press in early 2010. Freeman is perhaps best known for his award-winning book [*Strategic Management: A Stakeholder Approach*](#), originally published in 1984 and reprinted 2010 by Cambridge University Press, in which he suggests that businesses build their strategy around their relationships with key stakeholders. In 2013 and in 2008 he received honorary doctorates (Doctor Honoris Causa) from Radboud University Nijmegen (in Management Science) and Universidad Pontificia Comillas in Madrid (in Economics) for his work on stakeholder theory and business ethics. He has been honored with teaching awards from Wharton, Minnesota, Darden, UVA, and the Commonwealth of Virginia. He is a lifelong student of martial arts, philosophy, and the blues.
