

## **Ans Kolk**

### **Professor of Sustainable Management, Amsterdam Business School**

Ans Kolk is chair of the strategy & marketing section and professor of sustainable management at the University of Amsterdam Business School (ABS). In the period 2002-2009, she was the research director of the Amsterdam Business School. Her areas of research, teaching and publications are in corporate social responsibility, sustainability and environmental management, especially in relation to the strategy and management of international business firms, and international policy. Professor Kolk has published in a range of international journals, including *Journal of International Business Studies*, *Journal of World Business*, *Management International Review*, *International Business Review*, *International Marketing Review*, *California Management Review*, *Harvard Business Review*, *Journal of Management Studies*, *Journal of Business Ethics*, *Business and Society*, *Business Strategy and the Environment*, *World Development*, *European Management Journal*, *European Accounting Review*, *International Environmental Affairs*, *Environmental Politics*, and *Business and Politics*. She has also written many book chapters, published *Economics of Environmental Management* (Financial Times Prentice Hall) and *International Business and Global Climate Change* (Routledge, with Jonatan Pinkse).

Professor Kolk has been involved in organisational matters (including panel organisation, chair and board roles, review activities) and presented papers at various international academic conferences. She organised, with Carnegie Mellon University, an international conference on international corporate responsibility, held in Amsterdam in 2004; and also the academic conference as part of the Amsterdam Global Conference of Sustainability and Transparency (Global Reporting Initiative) in 2008 and 2010. Professor Kolk has been involved in several international projects on strategy, organisation and disclosure related to social and environmental issues, in cooperation with different private, public and civil society organisations (including the KPMG international surveys of sustainability/corporate responsibility reporting in 1998/1999, 2001/2002 and 2004/2005), and participates in externally-funded international research networks. Professor Kolk is a regular reviewer for international journals, and serves as editorial board member for *Journal of International Business Studies*, *Journal of Business Ethics*, *Business and Society*, *European Management Journal*, *Business Strategy and the Environment*, *Multinational Business Review*, *Organization and Environment*, and *Management Online Review*. In 2009, she received the Aspen Institute Faculty Pioneer European Award (Lifetime Achievement Award).
