Associate Professor of European Union Law University of Teramo

Pia Acconci has been a researcher and a professor of European Union Law and International Law for more than ten years.

In particular, she got a Ph.D. in International Economic Law at the Università Commerciale L. Bocconi, Milan in 1997, an Italian National Research Council (CNR) Fellowship from 1998 to 1999 and was awarded the special prize “eccellenza nella ricerca” (“Excellency in Research”) at the Università Commerciale L. Bocconi, Milan in 2002. Meanwhile, she has taught at several universities in Italy. She has also been a Professor of International Law on Investments on a temporary appointment at the Amsterdam Law School of the University of Amsterdam (2002, 2005 and 2006).

She has been member of the Italian Society of International Law (since 1997), member of the Editing Staff of the Italian Yearbook of International Law (since 1999), member of the Italian Branch of the International Law Association (since 2004) and member of the Committee on International Law concerning Foreign Direct Investment of the International Law Association (2004-2008).

She is the author of many articles and one book on “The Link between State and Company in the Field of Foreign Investments” (Padua, CEDAM, 2002), as well as the editor of “Corporate Social Responsibility in Europe” (Naples, ESI, 2009). She is also the editor of the “Newsletter on Corporate Social Responsibility in European Union law” which is available on the website of the University of Teramo (<http://www.unite.it/csr>). Her writings mainly concern the requirement of corporate nationality in international investment law, corporate social responsibility in international law and European Union law, the protection of non-trade values, particularly health, in international law.
